You are about to purchase a product that is not simple and may be difficult to understand.

What is this product?

Type: Investor shares of a Sub-Fund of an Open-Ended Umbrella Registered Alternative Investment Fund, namely MFO RAIF V.C.I.C. PLC, as provided in the Alternative Investment Fund Law, or in any other law which replaces or amends it. The RAIF is not authorised by CySEC and this registration into the RAIF’s Register is not equivalent to authorisation by CySEC.

Term: The Sub-Fund is set up for an indefinite period but may be liquidated in accordance with section 18 of the Fund’s Prospectus.

Objectives: The investment objective of the Sub-Fund is to maximize risk adjusted returns by investing in publicly listed shipping markets across the capital structure and market segments. The Sub-Fund may gain exposure either through common shares or preferred shares, bonds, or any publicly traded shipping security. The strategy will focus on portfolio diversification and risk optimization and exploiting arbitrage opportunities. Risk will be assessed on individual investments as well as on a portfolio level. The Manufacturer will employ efficient portfolio management techniques including the use of derivatives for hedging purposes if considered appropriate. In addition, the Manufacturer may open short positions on selected shipping stocks. The Sub-Fund’s short positions shall not exceed 25% of its total assets. The Sub-Fund is actively managed without any benchmark reference.

Depository: Eurobank Limited

SFDR Classification: Article 6

Intended Retail Investor: The Sub-Fund is addressed to Professional and Well-Informed Investors, with sufficient knowledge and experience and a long investment horizon, who can accept a possible loss on the investment amount. The Sub-Fund aims to generate its returns firstly from capital gains and to a lesser extent from periodic income.

Subscriptions and Redemption: Investors can subscribe or redeem their Investor Shares on a monthly basis at the applicable NAV, calculated based on the provisions of the Fund’s Prospectus. There is a redemption (subscription) notice period of at least 15 (7) calendar days, and the External Manager has the right to accept redemptions up to 25% of investors’ shares on each redemption date. Moreover, the Sub-Fund has a lock-up period of 6 months, following the subscription day, at which redemptions will not be allowed. This share class is available to Eligible Investors whose subscription in the Sub-Fund is completed within the initial offer period and amounts to at least USD 1,000,000.

Distribution Policy: The net-of-management fees annual income of the share class shall be distributed to investors, subject to liquidity and the profit availability of the entire Sub-Fund. However, the AIFM reserves the right not to declare dividends to the holders of Investor Shares - Founder Class A where the AIFM in its discretion deems appropriate.

Other Income: This share class is entitled to the Founder Preferred Dividend and the Founder Performance Income subject the Founder High Water mark, in accordance with

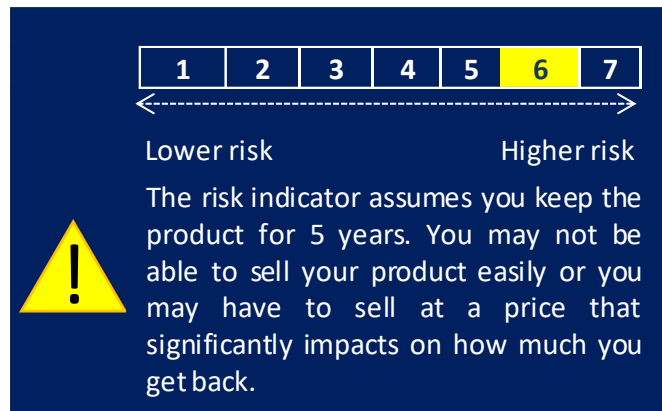
section 18 of the Product's Supplement in the Fund's Prospectus.

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The risk indicator assumes you keep the product for 5 years. You may not be able to sell your product easily or you may have to sell at a price that significantly impacts on how much you get back.

MFO Asset Management Ltd is the management company of the Fund. The Fund is operating with a depositary in accordance with section 26 of the AIF Law and section 23 of the AIFM Law. The depositary of the Fund is Eurobank Limited. The Fund does not offer any guaranteed returns and is not covered by any guaranteed compensation scheme. Investors can lose the whole of their investments. The Sub Fund's assets are segregated from those of the External Manager and from other sub-funds.

What are the costs?

Costs over Time

The tables show the amounts that are taken from your investment to cover different types of costs. These amounts depend on how much you invest, and how long you hold the product and how well the product does. - In the first year you will get back the amount that you invested (0% annual return). For the other holding periods we have assumed the product performs as shown in the moderate scenario;
